Bringing hope to a hungry world

Mary's Meals sets up school feeding programmes in some of the world's poorest communities, where poverty and hunger prevent children from gaining an education.

Our idea is a simple one that works:

- We provide a daily meal in a place of learning to attract chronically hungry children into the classroom, where they receive the education that could be their ladder out of poverty.
- In schools where children receive Mary's Meals, there is a rise in enrolment, attendance, and attainment.
- We are a global movement of people from all walks of life, united by our belief that no child in this world of plenty should endure a day without a meal. Together, we are helping to transform the lives of more than two million impoverished children every school day.

With 67 million primary school-age children currently out of school globally and many more attending classes too hungry to learn, our work is only just beginning.



We are committed to keeping our running costs low. From every £1, we spend at least 93p on our charitable activities.

Each meal, served in a place of education, costs just 10p.



Little acts of love

Mary's Meals was born in 2002, when our founder, Magnus MacFarlane-Barrow, visited Malawi during a famine and met a mother named Emma, who was dying from AIDS. When he asked her eldest son, Edward, what his dreams were in life, he replied simply...

"I want to have enough food to eat and to go to school one day."

These words from Edward ignited our mission – and from humble beginnings feeding just 200 children at a school in Malawi, we now reach more than two million children across the world every school day.

It is thanks to the efforts of our global family of supporters that we are able to keep our promise of a nutritious meal every school day to these children. Today they sit inside a classroom with full stomachs, gaining the education that could be their path to a brighter future.

Most of our work is done by thousands of volunteers all over the world, who carry out lots of little acts of love on behalf of Mary's Meals.

Our work is named after Mary, the mother of Jesus, who brought up her own child in poverty. We consist of, respect, and reach out to people of all faiths and none.
